The project starts on 1st March 2021 and finishes on 31st December 2021.

- have a clean criminal record (a relevant document should be sent to 3 us after the recruitment).

OTHER REQUIREMENTS





Volunteers do not need to have any special qualifications to work with children, but some experience in the field is essential. They should be ready to work with a big group of kids for a long period of time, have good interpersonal skills and basic knowledge of the development and needs of primary school and pre-school children.

An interest in sports, art, dancing, theatre, circus tricks or music would be an advantage, because those classes are very appreciated by our pupils.

Having manual and computer skills will be very useful in helping teachers too. Good organizational skills are crucial due to to the importance of planning and leading volunteer's own activities and supporting important events.

Participants are expected to be open and ready to share own ESC experience with the local community during different events (picnics, festivals, conferences).

PRACTICAL ARRANGEMENTS AND WHAT WE DO PROVIDE



- Polish language course (twice a week, 4 school hours, obligatory for 2 months), online Polish language course afterwards;
- Obligatory on-arrival and mid-term trainings in Poland;
- 7 hours of work per day, including a Polish language course (35-38 hours per week);
- All the required medical examinations, health and safety training at the beginning of the project and 4-days long preparatory workshops led by Prom.

- Monthly pocket money: 120 euro/month (ticket to the cinema: 4-8 euro, beer in a pub: from 2 euros, joga classes: single ticket 8 euro);
- Food money: 90 euro/month (prices in Poland: bread - 1 euro, milk - 0,75 euro per liter, sugar - 0,75 euro per kilo, 1 scoop of ice-cream - 1 euro). This money is enough to buy basic food to cook at home, not to go to restaurants;
- Reimbursement of the travel costs from the city of origin to Wroclaw and back (up to the amount based on the ESC Distance Calculator, excessive amount will be payed by the volunteer);
- Local transportation ticket (for trams, buses and night buses)

- Place in a room shared with other volunteers or students (with Internet access, equipped kitchen, fresh towels, bedsheets and a blanket). The flats have a "student standard"
- Mentor's care.



WHAT WILL YOU GAIN?





- increase your language skills (learn the basics of Polish language, deepen the knowledge of English);
- learn how to work in a group and resolve conflicts (you will become more flexible and ready to adapt to changes in the environment after such a long stay in a foreign country);
- have a better understanding of cultural differences and to be able to accept them;
- learn many interesting ways/ methods of work with children, special games for different ages;
- be more self-confident, responsible and mature;

- become familiar with the Polish Education System and the needs of primary school and pre-school children;
- develop self-organized activities, learn how to plan and manage your time and finances;
- through regular meetings with the mentor and analysis of progress you will find the most effective way(s) for you to learn;
- observe work of different specialists (a speech therapist, a psychologist, etc.)
- learn how to promote a project and its results/values within the local community by acting and make new friends!

APPLICATION AND SELECTION PROCESS

The whole process will be held by the Coordinating Organization: Foundation of Social Integration Prom. Please, do not contact kindergartens directly, but us.

IMPORTANT

After reading all the applications we will contact pre-selected candidates for a Skype interview. You might be asked to talk with a kindergarten's representative (e.g. to check your English level). Final results will be announced by the second week of February.

DEADLINE

Apply before the 29th of January. Applications will only be considered if required documents are fully completed and have a picture.
