AIMS OF THE PROJECT

This Youth Exchange wants to tackle the issue of the non-critical use of media and social media and want to create new tools, useful for participants, partners and all possible stakeholders.

These tools will be a collection of guidelines and rules to encourage a responsible approach to the use of media.

Raise the awareness among young people on the issue through non-formal education activities making them more aware of the risks and consequences that can be encountered with inappropriate use of social networks

Spread this awareness through the use of videos and infographics within the associations and schools of the participants

Start a shared analysis on what may be the cause of problems we see in the wrong use of media

Create a list of rules and a video on the critical approach to the media resulting from the effort of the participants to be disseminated to the partner associations of the project and in the school contexts of the participants

PARTICIPANTS/GROUP LEADERS

Each partner should send a group of 5 people (4 participants aged 18–25 years old and 1 group leader, without limitation in age).

PARTICIPANT'S PROFILE:

Basic knowledge of English

Interested in the topic of the YE (usage of social media, cyber bullying,

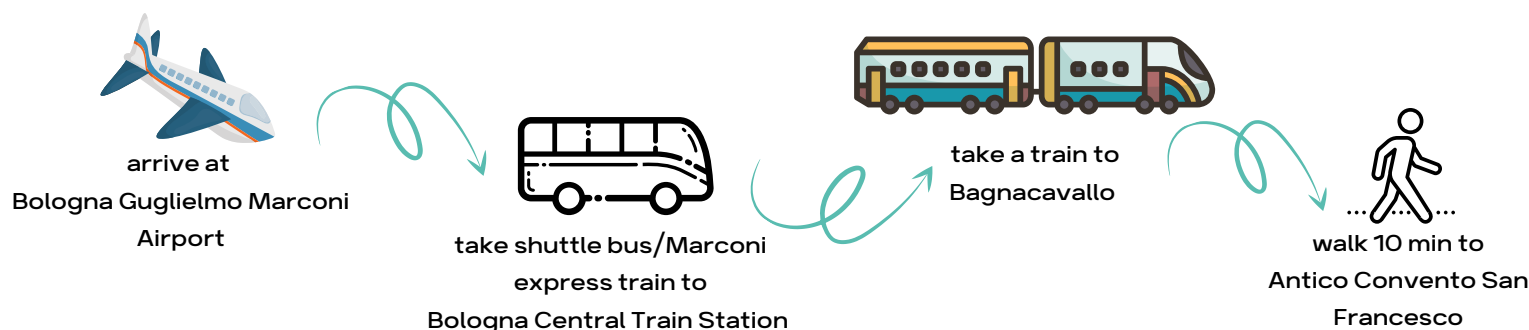
stereotypes transmitted through social media and fake news)

TRAVEL:

You are allowed to come only 2 extra days before or after the project dates, but accommodation and food cannot be funded.

ACCOMMODATION:

The Youth Exchange will be hosted in "**Antico Convento San Francesco**", a building property of the Municipality of Bagnacavallo, now managed by a young couple that has turned it into an affordable hotel.

The bedrooms are for 4-6-8 people and every room has a toilet with a shower.

TRAVEL COSTS AND REIMBURSEMENT:
