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DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT

A volunteer can combine activities according to his or her own interests - media, sport, creation, dance,

project activity, work with small children, work in youth clubs, etc.

2/ The volunteer within the strategic EVS will be integrated into activities in cooperation with associated

organizations in the microregion Ivančicko, Krumlovsko and Kahan. The volunteer will participate in annual

events such as the Microregion Festival (Municipalities), the Restaurant Day (associations) and the European

Day of Languages (Schools). These actions are intended as complementary activities to enhance the systemic

impact. These actions reach a large number of people and are therefore suitable for promoting volunteering,

EVS and Erasmus+.

3/ Other activities that the volunteer will do are: Czech language teaching, creation of own projects/

miniprojects/events/programs, promotion of EVS and Erasmus+ program, participation in educational

seminars, creation of media spots, promotion and decoration of the building.

MAIN TASKS OF VOLUNTEERS

to participate in regular pedagogical activities of the organization

to participate in occasional events for the public

to take initiative in youth club activities

to organize monthly one voluntary event

to prepare presentation about an own country

to create an own project/miniproject





to participate in public events/activities within associated organizations to attend the On-Arrival Training, Mid-term Meeting and other trainings to prepare visual documentation and archieve of their own project activities to learn Czech language

Besides all these, the volunteer is encouraged to come with new ideas, youth initiative, youth exchanges, or other kind of projects which can be suitable for hosting organization.

PROJECT MANAGEMENT

Coordination of the project means setting contractual relationships with involved organizations, managing and evaluating the project.

The contractual relationships between the volunteer, the sending and the receiving organizations will be addressed by the Volunteer Agreement, in which the project is described in detail and signed by the volunteer, the sending and receiving organization before the start of EVS. The VA respects the EVS Charter at each point. The VA stipulates the rules of cooperation (communication, basic values of cooperation, crisis





situations), duties and tasks at all stages of the project, financial management and grant allocation, description of the activity and definition of the tasks to be performed by the volunteer and expected learning outcomes.

The sending organization is responsible for volunteer preparation, support during all phases of the project, ensuring the volunteer's participation in the annual meeting, helping with reintegration into the home country, ensuring sharing of experience gained during the project. It is involved in working up the final report.

The receiving organization is responsible for organizational, administrative and financial management of the project. It cooperates with and communicates with all stakeholders - both with the sending organization and the volunteer. It provides support in practical and organizational matters. It provides the necessary documents to receive a volunteer. In the case of a visa process, it provides visa documents. It provides support before, during and after EVS, it provides a mentor and teaching the Czech language. It distributes the grant, it provides support for obtaining health insurance, a visa and a Youthpass certificate.

The financial management of the project is coordinated by EVS coordinator with the financial officer of SVČ. According to the Volunteer Agreement, we will transfer the financial amount for the sending of a volunteer to the sending organization. According to established standards, we will pay the volunteer for travel costs, individual support, and meals.

Workers who will participate in the volunteer support system:

support in administrative, practical and financial matters - EVS coordinator and financial officer support related to the individual tasks - leaders ie internal employees of SVČ - pedagogoue of leisure time activities and EVS Coordinator

personal support, learning support and intercultural learning - mentor

language support - qualified lecturer

training cycle support - EVS coordinator
