



How to reach Kielce

- Take a flight to Warsaw (Warszawa) Chopin Airport or Cracow (Kraków)
- Take a bus or train from there to Kielce
- We're gathering in Kielce. Private transport will be provided from Kielce to the venue in Kaczyn.

• For Czech participants: take any land transport from your country to Crakow (Kraków), Częstochowa, Wrocław or Katowice (the best choice is Cracow because it is the easiest to reach Kielce from there, we do not recommend Wrocław if you have other options). From one of these cities take a bus/train to Kielce. Flights as above are also possible but it's not much faster than bus/train.



### How to reach Kielce from Warsaw Chopin Airport

You need to catch a train to the main railway station or take a flix bus from the west station or the airport.

- Koleje Mazowieckie (get off on the Warszawa Centralna Station)
- SKM (get off Warszawa Śródmieście [you must go to the Warszawa Centralna trough underground corridors - there will be the inform table]), from Warszawa Centralna, you can catch the train to Kielce (there is a schedule: <u>https://rozklad-</u> <u>pkp.pl/en</u>)




