

Training Course: Expect the unexpected

18-27 may 2022

(Arrival the 17th of May/Departure the 28th of May)

Summary :

The COVID-19 health crisis was not the first crisis, and will not be the last, whether at a regional, national or even global level. The Caribbean and La Reunion are hit each year by Hurricanes/Cyclones of varying intensities (cf. Hurricane Maria and Irma, Cyclone Dumile), Europe and the Caribbean are affected by Earthquakes, floods, storms, heat waves ... and these risks are not about to diminish with climate change, on the contrary (cf. "Climate change constitutes a major new threat to public health. Climate variability and its warming causes death and disease through the natural disasters it causes - such as heat waves, floods and droughts. "- World Health Organisation).

Faced with the scale of the COVID-19 health crisis, two points were put forward by European and local youth organizations with which D'Antilles and D'Ailleurs collaborated:

- 1) Solidarity between youth structures in order to support and help each other and exchange tools. On this point in particular, during the crisis, DA&DA had several exchanges with different partners in order to find the best solutions to accompany and support young people currently in mobility projects (hosted or sent).
- 2) This crisis and the exchanges carried out with different youth organizations in Martinique, the Caribbean and Europe have demonstrated the needs of these structures in terms of acquisition of tools, methods, sharing of experiences and creation of a network of support and advice organizations in crisis management.

Main objective :

The "Expect the unexpected" training aims to develop and equip youth workers with effective knowledge and tools for managing crisis situations during European youth projects related to mobility.

Specific objectives:

- Have in each partner organization a person (ambassador) trained in crisis management (empowered in first aid techniques, risk assessment, support for young people, etc.).
- Allow youth workers to share good practices, challenges and experiences in managing young people in crisis.
- Develop a guide for youth organizations working in mobility giving advice and offering different methods for monitoring volunteers, administrative points to monitor, stress management, risk assessment and actions to be taken.
- Analyze the contexts and risks faced by young people during mobility projects;
- Improve the skills of youth actors in the context of their mission of support and accompaniment of young people, in particular during crisis situations;
- Develop the knowledge of youth actors on the specificities, administrative in particular of European youth programs;
- Create concrete and lasting partnerships allowing the creation of a network of youth organizations for support and support and the exchange of experiences and good practices, especially during crisis situations;

- Exchange around tools and methods allowing to develop the resilience of young people and youth actors.
