DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT



"Managing Diversity for More Inclusive Youth Work in Europe" aims to support 30 youth workers, educators and youth trainers across Europe in the development of their diversity management skills and in learning how to implement a culture of diversity in their working environments by increasing diversity-oriented awareness in their work with young people.

The project is born out of our concern that many young people in Europe lack opportunities and spaces to get involved and express themselves. Being different from mainstream societies, many are being excluded and marginalized.



ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE INFORMATION



The Training Course will take place from **11th to 16th of June, 2022** in **Ommen, The Netherlands**.

The **10th of June** is Arrival Day. **17th of June** is a Departure Day.

The selected participants will be asked to fill in an online **Registration Form**. This will help the organizing team to develop a program that meets your expectations.

NOTE! You can arrive a couple of days earlier or stay a couple of days longer to see around or to travel a bit. However, this should be done at your **own expense**. The Hosting organization can help you to find accommodation for extra days, but you should bear those extra costs.

VISA INFORMATION



Participants from **Armenia, Belarus and Turkey** will need a visa to enter the Netherlands and the hosting organization will support this process.

All the visa costs will be covered by organizers upon presentation of original receipts. The invitation letters will be prepared and sent to the participants by JUB.

HOW TO GET TO OLDE VEChte, OMMEN



You could arrive via **Amsterdam Airport Schiphol** or from **Eindhoven airport**:

From **Schiphol**, you buy a train ticket to Ommen at the ticket machine. The ticket does not have a specific time; trains go about every 30 min and it takes about **1,5 hours**. To know the exact time, platform number and stepover in Zwolle check **www.ns.nl**.

From **Eindhoven** airport, you go first with a bus to Eindhoven Station (bus ticket at the machine). There you buy a train ticket to Ommen at the ticket machine. The ticket does not have a specific time; trains go about every 30 min and it takes about 2,5 hours. To know the exact time, platform number and stepovers (probably Utrecht and Zwolle) check **www.ns.nl**.

After Ommen station it is a **15 min walk** (**Address: Olde Vechte, Zeesserweg 12**).



THE PROFILE OF THE PARTICIPANTS



The Long Term Training Course is intended for youth workers, youth trainers, and educators who are ready to work on the topics of diversity, inclusion, and anti-discrimination in order to activate the potential of diversity in training and work with young people at national and the European levels.

Each sending organization of the project will be responsible for the selection of youth workers affiliated with their organizations. We will select 10 youth workers with fewer opportunities, especially those living in hostile communities where their gender expression is not respected and they are excluded and marginalized.

FINANCIAL CONDITIONS



100% of the total travel expenses will be reimbursed.

Reimbursement will be done in EUR, regardless of the currency indicated on the ticket and receipt/invoice. Any tickets purchased in a local currency other than EUR will then be converted and calculated according to the exchange rate of the month given by the European Commission.

NOTE! Please check the travel budget limits above. If travel costs exceed the amount budgeted in the project, the organizers will only be able to reimburse participants the maximum travel costs indicated in the travel budget. You are therefore strongly advised to consult the tickets with us and book your flights well in advance.

IMPORTANT! According to the sustainability policy of the organizers, only the tickets that are bought 1 month before the activity starts can be reimbursed. Reimbursement: All the participants will receive the travel reimbursement through a bank transfer.

- Tickets (there must be price and name of the person stated on it).
- Boarding passes (in case of loss – please get a confirmation from the airlines, that the flight was taken)
- Invoices – yes, even if you have a ticket, our accounting still needs an invoice.

ACCOMMODATION



During the Training Course in the Netherlands, the participants will stay at **Olde Vechte** in **Ommen**. JUB has booked this venue before for similar events.

INSURANCE

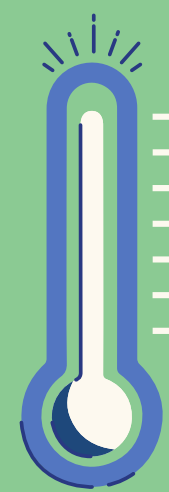
