Boosting Inclusion Through Youth Work Vol. 2

"Boosting Inclusion Through Youth Work Vol. 2" is a follow-up project of a TC which we have successfully implemented in 2022.

The training course "BITYW 2" aims to create a special programme in which youth workers would include refugees in their work with youth.

The second part of the project continues the work of the first project, using youth work to integrate refugees and migrants. The rising number of irregular migrants highlights the need for this work. The aim is to improve youth work, integrate refugees, promote positive public opinion, and explore the role of youth work in promoting social integration and cultural exchange. The continuation of the project will reach more youth workers and refugees and have a greater impact.

B.I.T.Y.W.2 aims to eventually make Europeans more welcoming and ready for the opportunities granted by the refugees. Most of all, use this potential to enhance youth work, hence, grow open-minded youth.


THE PLFASE BF MINDFUL OF GENDER BALANCE OF THE GROUPS

ACCOMMODATION

TRANSPORTS

The nearest airport from Tropea is Lamezia Terme or Reggio Calabria, but probably there aren't direct flight from your Country. You can check cheap flight on skyscanner.com or Kiwi.com

You can book a flight to Lamezia Terme with a stop in Rome or Milan or a direct flight to Rome or Naples and then take a train/bus from Rome/Naples to Tropea

It's mandatory to buy tickets on the air-company website (not eDreams, etc.) You should arrive in Tropea by the evening of the 14th May and your departure must be in the mooring of 23rd May.

It's (mandatory) really important to send us your travel plan before booking the tickets. Don't hesitate to contact us for any travel advice! We are ready to help you!



REIMBURSMENT

To be reimbursed for your trip. The following are necessary: 1) Tickets and boarding passes. 2) Invoice/ receipt/ booking email. Keep your bus/train tickets as well! Transportation by taxi is not reimbursable.

Your travel expenses will be reimbursed after the project by bank transfer to the partner association or one of the participant. If you fail to provide the necessary travel documents, we will be unable to reimburse you.


