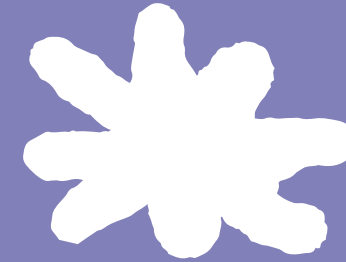


WHY ARTIVISM?

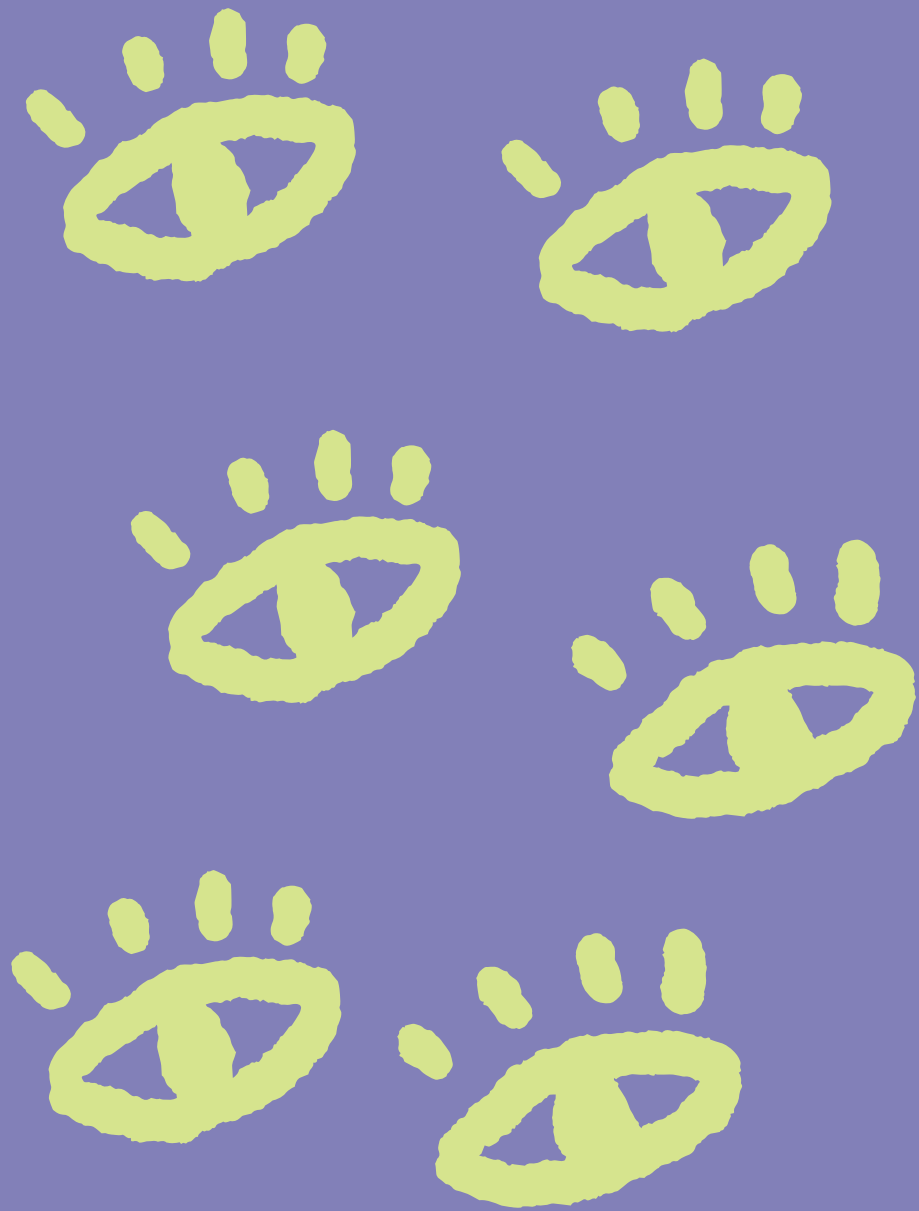
