THEATRE OF THE OPPRESSED AND FORUM THEATRE

are transformative theatrical tools that use the body for expression and reflection, placing theatre in service of education and collective empowerment

PLAYBACK THEATRE

is a form of improvisational theatre in which the audience and/or group members tell stories from their lives and watch them enacted on stage.

DEEP DEMOCRACY

is a psycho-social-political paradigm and methodology, that focuses on the awareness of voices/experiences/opinions that are both central and marginal. It is a principle that, unlike "classical" democracy, which focuses on majority rule, Deep Democracy, suggests that all voices/experiences/opinions are important.



PROCESS WORK

offers a model that integrates and utilises contributions from various disciplines to facilitate transformation and growth, both individually and collectively. PW primarily focuses on developing a state of consciousness ; that is, helping people and groups become aware of how they perceive and experience things and learn to change their approach.


