# **Inclusion in Action: Gen(der)eration Equality**

## **Project Objective(s)**

The primary objective of the project is to provide 24 participants with a comprehensive understanding of gender equality, including the intersection of disability and other factors such as socio-economic status, ethnicity, and geographical location.

The project intends to create a platform for dialogue, exchange of experiences, and peer-to-peer learning between youth workers from diverse cultural and social contexts. By doing so, we aim to enhance their ability to evaluate existing policies, implement intersectional analyses, and develop innovative solutions to address gender inequality and promote inclusion.

## Participants' profile

Our primary target group is people fitting this profile:  
**youth workers, youth practitioners, public sector employees**  
(people working in municipality, public youth centers, community centers,  
women centers and similar), **social workers** and  
professionals in the social care sector (**psychologists, social pedagogists**) and  
**educators** working with youth in both formal and nonformal education.

Since our work will focus on intersectional analysis of gender equality of  
people with disabilities, people from rural area and people belonging to  
national / gender / sexual minorities, all of our participants will have either  
hands-on experience working with those youth subgroups or experience in  
youth policy and gender policy drafting and implementing fields.

## Travel Information – How to Arrive to Šabac

If you are arriving to Belgrade Airport (Nikola Tesla Airport), please follow the instructions below.

### From the airport to Belgrade bus station

You can take the A1 shuttle bus from the airport to the main bus station.

#### A1 Shuttle Bus Route

The bus departs every 30 minutes.

The ticket price is 3–4 EUR, and you pay inside the shuttle bus — only in Serbian dinars.

We recommend exchanging a small amount of money, as the exchange rate there is not very favorable, at the airport to cover this cost.

Alternatively, you can take bus number 600 which also goes from the airport to the main bus station.

### From Belgrade to Šabac

Once you arrive at the Belgrade bus station, you can buy ticket to travel to Šabac directly at the station counter.

Tickets can be paid in cash (RSD – dinars) or by card.

Buses to Šabac operate regularly, at least once per hour, until 21:15 in the evening.

The ticket price is approximately 7–11 EUR, depending on the bus company.

#### Taxi option

There is also an option to take a line taxi directly from Belgrade Airport to Šabac.

The cost of this transfer is 50 EUR per taxi (not per person) and this amount will be included in your travel budget.

If you decide to take a taxi from the airport to Šabac, please let us know in advance.

Our team can arrange a shared taxi (line taxi) for you to ensure a safe and coordinated trip.

Please note that this price applies from the airport, not from Belgrade city center.

#### Arrival in Šabac

If you are coming by bus, please inform us of your arrival time at the Šabac bus station, so that we can arrange for someone to pick you up and accompany you to the accommodation.



# Accommodation and working space

During the seminar, the accommodation and working space will be the Science Center at Nikole Tesle bb, Šabac.

Each room will accommodate 2 people. You need to bring your own personal hygiene kit and towels.

Three meals a day will be served, along with coffee breaks.

Internet is available throughout the facility.
