Group transfer by bus from Thessaloniki to Arnaia will be organized by us.

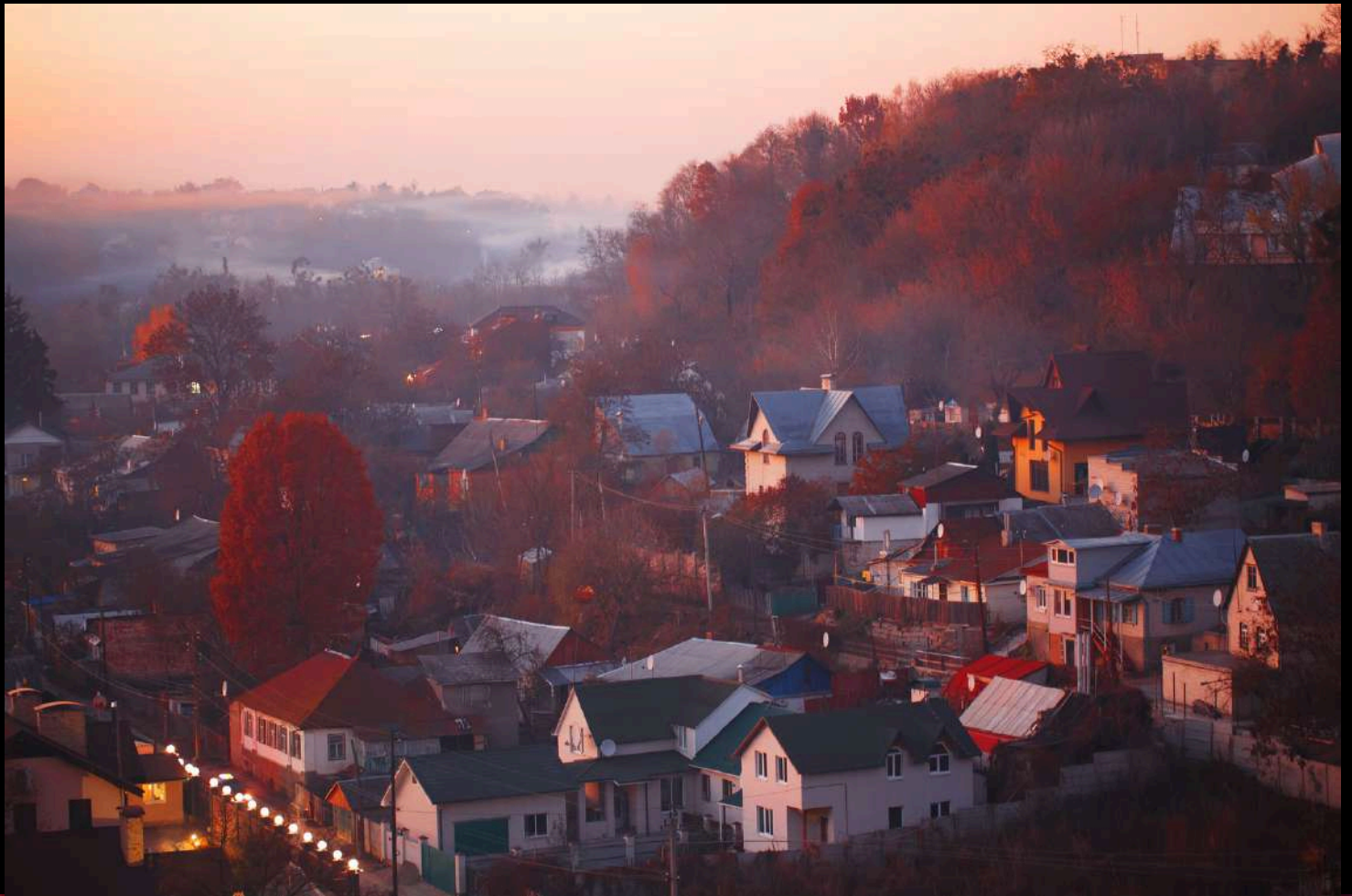
- From the airport, take bus **01X** – Airport to City Center

Travel Reimbursement

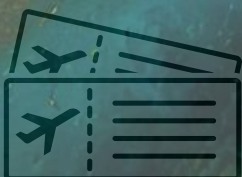
All travel costs are calculated according to the Erasmus+ distance calculator and so the maximum travel cost reimbursement for each participant per country is:

Travel costs will be reimbursed by bank transfer only after all participants send their original boarding passes, receipts, invoices and tickets to the organizers by post and via e-mail (original & scanned versions) to finance@aristotales.gr.

Note:

To ensure you get the correct reimbursement, calculate the distance between your home and Thessaloniki, Greece with this calculator : [here](#)

- For travel distances between 100 and 499 KM: 211 EUR per participant
- For travel distances between 500 and 1999 KM: 309 EUR per participant
- For travel distances between 2000 and 2999 KM: 395 EUR per participant



REIMBURSEMENT

What to Bring

Please make sure you bring the following items with you:

- Valid ID, Passport, or other required travel document
- European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) (mandatory for EU participants)
- Any personal medication you may need during the activity
- Pack light clothes: t-shirts, swimsuit, a light jacket, summer clothes, and walking shoes. Don't forget sunglasses and sunscreen.
- Cables, chargers, and adaptors for your electronic devices
- Personal toiletries, including towels, shampoo, shower gel, slippers, and any other items you may need for daily use
- A bottle for water (Thermos)
